She provided impeccable customer service and commitment to ensuring that social workers, foster parents, students, and community professionals obtained the resources they needed to serve kids and families. Dana is appreciated and will certainly be missed.

To allow time for this management transition, the Library will be closed during the month of July. The target reopening date for the Resource Library is August 2, 2010.
